Attributes of God Sermon Notes... God is Sovereign- Ezekiel 1:1-28

Ezekiel received a vision of God in His chariot and upon His throne, revealing God to be the <u>Sovereign</u> King who rules over all things.

God's sovereignty is a great source of <u>comfort</u> to the believer.

In the New Testament, we see that <u>Jesus</u> is the Resurrected & Sovereign King who is able to accomplish our salvation.

- 5. Does the truth that God is sovereign over all things bring up any questions or difficulties in your mind?
- 6. Have you lived through or witnessed any difficult circumstances where it was hard to trust God's sovereignty? What helped you?
- 7. Why does the unbelieving world probably hate the God's being the sovereign king more than any other attribute?
- 8. How are you comforted, as a Christian, by the knowledge that God is the Sovereign King?
- 9. In what struggles, trials, and uncertainties do you need to more fully trust God's sovereignty?
- 10. Jesus is the resurrected and sovereign king who is able to accomplish our salvation. How do we see this portrayed in Revelation 1:9-20?
