Questions for Discussion & Application:

6. How has God demonstrated His faithful love towards you?
7. As Christians, we can certainly relate to the unfaithfulness of Israel, but what is different about how we relate to God? (Jeremiah 31:31-34).
8. How does God's faithfulness personally encourage you?
9. How does God's faithfulness give us confidence that we will persevere in the Christian life? (Philippians 1:6, I Corinthians 1:7-9, & I Thessalonians 5:23-24)
10. How can you show the faithful character of God in your relationships with others?
