Attributes of God Sermon Notes... The LORD is Truthful - 2 Corinthians 1:18-20

God made a promise to Abraham (Genesis 12:1-3).

Abraham believed God's promise (Genesis 15:1-6).

Abraham struggled with doubt (Genesis 17:15-21).

God kept His promise (Genesis 21:1-7).

Questions for Discussion & Application:

- 1. What was helpful, confusing, or challenging from this study of God's Word?
- 2. How do we see the truthfulness of God expressed through the life of Abraham in our passage from Genesis 12-21?
- 3. What other examples of God's truthfulness and promises kept can you think of from the Bible?

4. Why is it so important that we understand God to be perfectly truthful? How does God's truthfulness shape our view of the Scripture?

5. How does fulfilled prophecy confirm the truthfulness of God? What prophecies in Scripture can we point to as being fulfilled? (See Isaiah 52:13-53:12 for an example.)

- 6. What promises of God do we enjoy the fulfillment of as Christians? (Jeremiah 31:31-34 & Ezekiel 36:25-28)
- 7. What promises of God do we look forward to God fulfilling in the future? (See Revelation 21:1-22:6 for an example.)

8. What can we do if we are struggling to trust God's promises and Word?

9. How can we be like God in being truthful people? Why is this so important?

10. Is there any area of your life where you need to be more truthful? How will you respond if the Spirit is revealing patterns or areas where you have been untruthful?
