Can anyone or anything separate us from the <u>love</u> of Christ?

No, in all things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us!

Questions for Discussion & Application:

- 1. What was difficult, helpful, or challenging from this study of God's Word?
- 2. What has been most encouraging and helpful from our study of Romans 8?
- 3. Have you ever felt abandoned by God?
- 4. If so, why do you think you felt this way?
- 5. How does our passage today, correct this way of thinking and feeling?
- 6. Despite whatever adversity, trial, or difficulty we face in life, how are we able to be confident that we will experience overwhelming victory? (see verse 37)
- 7. This victory refers to our persevering in the faith despite trials and difficulty. How should we understand those who once professed to be Christians but have completely abandoned their faith in Christ? (see I John 2:19 & Luke 8:4-8)
- 8. Is the focus in our passage on OUR love for God as the reason we persevere or is it God's love for us? Why does this matter so much?
- 9. There are so many areas of life where we face uncertainty, but NOTHING can separate you from God's love for you in Christ! How does this certainty change the way you live your life?
- 10. What is one specific way that you will apply today's passage in your own life?
