

The Creator God is Eternal and Self-Existing

“I AM WHO I AM” is a statement that teaches us that God is the self-existing, eternal, Creator and cause of all things. He needs no other explanation than simply to say “I AM”!

Our response to the I AM should be reverence and obedience.

Jesus is revealed as the I AM in human flesh!

Questions for Discussion & Application:

1. Why is it so important that we study God’s attributes and grow in knowing who God actually is?
2. What attribute of God are you most curious to learn about? Why?
3. There is no higher or more valuable knowledge than the knowledge of God. Why is this statement true?
4. Why are people so prone to creating a false god in their minds? What is the correction for this tendency?
5. Was there anything especially interesting, helpful, or confusing in Exodus 3:1-4:17?
6. God revealed Himself to Moses as “I AM”. What is significant about this?
7. As we reflect on the end of one year and the beginning of another, we are reminded that we are created beings who exist within time. How is God different from us in regard to time?
8. How did Moses respond when he realized that God was speaking to Him? (Exodus 3:3-6)
9. What does an attitude of reverence and awe of God look like in your own life?
10. Moses was reluctant to obey God at first but it became easier as he more clearly saw the power of God as the eternal Creator. How has a greater knowledge of God enabled you to become more courageous to obey Him?
11. Is there any area where you need to be more fully obedient to God? What truth(s) about God will help you to obey?
12. Jesus revealed Himself to be the “I AM” in John 8:58-59. Why is it so important that we not miss this important point?
