The one who is in Christ is NOT CONDEMNED and is rescued from the <u>penalty</u> of sin.
The one who is in Christ is SET FREE from the <u>power</u> of sin.

- 6. What is the difference between dead religion and the true Christian life? What are some examples of dead religion?
- 7. Why is the Spirit able to live in the heart of the one who is in Christ and not condemned?
- 8. What things do we know that the Spirit will do in the heart and life of a believer? (John 3:6, John 16:8, Luke 24:49, Acts 4:31, Romans 8:26, Galatians 5:16, Galatians 5:22ff, and Colossians 1:8)
- 9. What evidence do you see in your life that sin's power has been broken by the Spirit?
- 10. Is there an area of your life where you need to further yield to the Spirit's leadership and control?
