Much Needed Perspective on Suffering – Romans 8:17-25

As the children of God, we are heirs of a glorious inheritance. (8:17a)

The inevitable path towards this future inheritance is one marked by suffering. (8:17b)

The sufferings of this present life are <u>nothing</u> compared to our glorious future. (8:18)

Along with all creation, we wait like a woman in labor for our full adoption when we will be given our new <u>resurrected</u> bodies to live forever with God in a perfect world. (8:19-23)

Because we have this <u>hope</u>, we wait for it with patience and are sustained by it. (8:24-25)

- 9. What does it look like in your life to wait for your future inheritance with patience?
- 10. What are some ways of thinking that we need to avoid that won't be helpful to us as we seek to wait for our future inheritance with patience?
