Questions for Discussion & Application:

- 6. How have you experienced being wrongly the object of hatred from the world because of your faith in Christ? How should we respond to this?
- 7. Who is the supreme example of love for us? (see verse 16)
- 8. How can we "lay down our lives" for one another? What example does John give in verse 17?
- 9. It is not enough to say that we love one another, it is necessary that this love be lived out and demonstrated through actions of kindness. How does this challenge you personally?
- 10. Is there a relationship where you need to ask God to help you love your brother or sister in Christ better?
