Perfect Love Casts Out Fear – I John 4:13-21

- 1. We can be confident that we know God because His Spirit lives in us (4:13-16).
 - The Spirit makes us able to confess that Jesus is the Son of God (4:15).
 - The Spirit makes us able to live in love (4:16).
- 2. God's <u>love</u> is being perfected in our lives (4:17-21).
 - ➤ The perfection of God's love drives out <u>fear</u> (4:17-18).
 - > The perfection of God's love drives out hatred (4:19-21).

Questions for Discussion & Application:

- 1. What was difficult, helpful, or challenging from this study of God's Word?
- 2. How much emphasis do you put on the role of the Holy Spirit in your own Christian life?
- 3. Why might we sometimes be tempted to underestimate the Spirit's role and importance in our lives?
- 4. What things does the Holy Spirit empower the Christian to do (4:15-16)?

- 5. What specific evidence of the Spirit's work do you see in your own life?
- 6. When God's love is perfected in us it drives out fear of judgment in our relationship with God (4:17-18). How have you experienced this to be true in your own life?
- 7. Do you ever struggle with fear of judgment? If so, how does this passage speak into this fear?
- 8. When God's love is perfected in us it drives out hatred and replaces it with love for others (4:19-21). How have you experienced this to be true in your own life?
- 9. What does this passage say is true of a person who claims to know God, to be a Christian, and to be filled with the Holy Spirit but does NOT live a life marked by love for other believers?
- 10. How is God growing you in unselfish and practical love for other believers?
