## Faith is the Victory! – I John 5:1-5 1. The true believer has faith, love, and obedience all intertwined in his life (5:1-2). 2. The true believer does NOT find the commands of God to be burdensome (5:3). 3. The true believer has victory over this world through his faith in Christ (5:4-5).

## **Questions for Discussion & Application:**

- 1. What was difficult, helpful, or challenging from this study of God's Word?
- 2. What are the 3 marks of a true believer that we have seen repeatedly in I John?
- 3. Why are these 3 marks so closely connected and interdependent upon each other?

- 4. Why would obeying God's commands ensure that we are also loving our brothers and sisters in Christ? (See John 13:34, Romans 12:10, Ephesians 4:32, & I Peter 4:9).
- 5. Why are God's commandments not burdensome for the believer? (see Matthew 11:28-30)
- 6. If we are finding God's instructions to be a burden, what might this reveal is going on in our hearts?
- 7. How have you personally found God's commands lead to joy, peace, and freedom rather than being a burden?
- 8. What does it mean to have victory that overcomes the world? What does God use to give us this victory? (see verse 4)
- 9. Why would our faith in the Lord be the means to our victory? (see I Corinthians 15:56-58 & Revelation 12:11)
- 10. What is a specific example of such faith-driven victory that you have seen in your own life?
