

# The Testimony of God – I John 5:6-12

1. The testimony of God about Jesus is seen in the Spirit, water, and blood (5:6-9).
2. Those who deny God's testimony about Jesus call God a liar (5:10).
3. What we do with the testimony of God about Jesus determines our salvation (5:11-12).

## **Questions for Discussion & Application:**

1. What was difficult, helpful, or challenging from this study of God's Word?
2. What are the 3 marks of a true believer that we have seen repeatedly in I John?
3. Which of these 3 marks is emphasized in our passage today?
4. There is a spiritual component to believing that Jesus is the Son of God (I John 5:10). How has the Spirit testified in your heart about Jesus?

5. In verse 9, John speaks of receiving the testimony of men. What men is he speaking of? (see I John 1:1-4)
6. God's testimony to Jesus has a historical component. How do the well-attested historical facts of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection encourage and support your faith?
7. What is the testimony that you have in your heart if you believe in Jesus? (see I John 5:11-13)
8. What does it mean to have the eternal life that comes from trusting in Jesus? (see John 17:3)
9. How does it change the way you live your daily life to know that you are forgiven and have a real relationship with God through Christ that will last forever?
10. What happens to the one who rejects God's testimony about His Son? (see I John 5:10 & 12) Does this burden you to tell others about Jesus?
