- 4. There is a spiritual component to believing that Jesus is the Son of God (I John 5:10). How has the Spirit testified in your heart about Jesus?

- 5. In verse 9, John speaks of receiving the testimony of men. What men is he speaking of? (see I John 1:1-4)
- 6. God's testimony to Jesus has a historical component. How do the well-attested historical facts of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection encourage and support your faith?
- 7. What is the testimony that you have in your heart if you believe in Jesus? (see I John 5:11-13)
- 8. What does it mean to have the eternal life that comes from trusting in Jesus? (see John 17:3)
- 9. How does it change the way you live your daily life to know that you are forgiven and have a real relationship with God through Christ that will last forever?
- 10. What happens to the one who rejects God's testimony about His Son? (see I John 5:10 & 12) Does this burden you to tell others about Jesus?
