Questions for Discussion and Reflection:

6. Verse 9 says that "the earth will be full of the knowledge of the LORD as the waters cover the sea." Why is such cosmic knowledge of God necessary for a world filled with peace to exist?

7. What does it look like in your life to await Jesus' return?

8. How does the confident hope of Jesus' return impact the way you pray? (see Matthew 5:10, Psalm 2, and Acts 4:23-31)

9. How should our lives look different from the world around us as we live as citizens of God's kingdom amidst a broken and fallen world? How does your life look different?

10. As a citizen of God's Kingdom, how is God using you to address both the physical and spiritual needs of those around you?
