5. How is it a temptation in your life to trust in people rather than God?

6. Verse 5 says that we are blessed when God is the object of our hope and trust. What does it mean to be blessed?
7. How have you personally experienced this blessing in your own life?
8. What reasons do we see in verses 6-10 for trusting God? How do we see the character of God as described in verses 7-9 lived out in Jesus' life?
9. In what way do you need to grow in trusting God rather than men, especially as you face enemies?
10. What will you do (specifically) in response to hearing God's Word today?
