Where Does Your Life Point? - John 1:19-51

When questioned by the religious leadership about his identity, John the Baptist minimized who he was and instead made much of <u>Jesus</u> (1:19-28).
John the Baptist also pointed His own disciples toward <u>Jesus</u> (1:29-42).
<u>Jesus</u> called His disciples to follow Him and pointed their attention to Himself (1:43-51).

Questions for Discussion & Application:

- 1. What was surprising, confusing, or helpful from today's passage?
- 2. What words or phrases are used to describe Jesus in this passage? Are there any that you do not understand? Which description of Jesus is most meaningful to you?
- 3. What things were impressive about John the Baptist? (see Matthew 11:11) Was John impressed with himself? Why not? (see verses 26-27)? How does a focus on the glory of Christ help us to also walk in humility as John the Baptist did?
- 4. In verses 35-37 who did John put the attention of his disciples upon? In your own life, how can you point the attention upon Jesus rather than yourself? Try to be specific.
- 5. What do you think Jesus meant in 1:50-51? What great things have you seen Jesus do?
