

Look! See! Behold! Jesus is the Messiah, who will make all things new! - John 2:1-12

- Jesus: beginning His ministry right where He will end it (1-2)
- Jesus: not what you want, but what you need (3-5)
- Jesus: bringer of a better wine (6-10)
- Jesus: the glory of God revealed in human flesh (11)

Questions for Discussion & Application:

1. What was surprising, confusing, or helpful from today's passage?
2. In what sense does Jesus' ministry begin and end in the same place (see Revelation 19:6-9)? Why might this be significant?
3. What things do we learn about Jesus from the miraculous sign of His turning a whole lot of water into the best of wine? How do these truths about Jesus impact you?
4. What else is Jesus in the business of making new and better? How have you experienced His power to make things new and better in your own life personally?
5. We see in verse 11 that Jesus' disciples responded to this sign by believing in Him. How are you encouraged to more deeply trust in Jesus from this look at His glory in today's passage?
