3. What does Jesus mean by "living water" (see John 7:38-39)? How have you experienced this living water in your life?
4. Jesus consistently turned the focus from physical things (birth, water, temple, food) and towards Himself. How does Jesus continue to do the same thing in your own life?
5. What did Jesus say was His food? What does it look like in your own life to value the food of God accomplishing His mission through you more than physical food, comfort, safety, etc.?
6. Why did many Samaritans believe? What is surprising about this?
