## OVERALL CHANGES

During the Fall semester, we have decided not to have afterschool or fellowship dinner. We are hoping this will allow us to keep doing Adult Bible Study, Youth, and WOW during the school year.

## WEDNESDAY NIGHTS

Our Wednesday Nights are going to look a little different this year! We will open the doors at 5:45. At 6:00 we will begin the night consisting of a game, announcements, and get started with either Student Community Groups or BIG Group! We are asking that students wear a mask once they enter our building until they have found their seat. Each night, the group will discuss a passage of scripture using the Swedish Method for Bible Study. Students will be given a booklet at the beginning of the semester. We would like them to bring this booklet and their Bible each week to youth. Our goal is to get students in the Word during the week on their own.
