

Who are you? – John 8:12-30

Jesus declares Himself to be the Light of the World (8:12).

Jesus' testimony about Himself is true (8:13-20).

Those who reject Jesus' testimony walk in the darkness of death (8:21-24).

Will you believe Jesus' testimony and have the light of life (8:25-30)?

Questions for Discussion & Application:

1. What was surprising, confusing, or helpful from today's passage?
2. What is significant about Jesus calling Himself the "Light of the world"?
3. What is the difference between having the light of life and walking in the darkness of death? What descriptions of walking in the darkness do we see here?
4. Have you ever had a difficult time convincing someone of something about yourself that you knew to be true? How did Jesus seek to persuade His audience that He really was the Light of the Word?
5. What is the only way to have the light of life and not die in our sins? How does this spur you on to share Jesus with others and let His light shine through you?
