The Hostility of the World – John 15:18-16:4a

Why does the world hate you? (15:18-20)

- The world hates you because it hated <u>Jesus</u> first. (15:18)
- The world hates you because you do NOT belong to it. (15:19)
- The world hates you because you are <u>NOT</u> greater than Jesus. (15:20)

Who else does the world hate besides Jesus and His disciples? (15:21-27)

What is the greater danger than being hated by the world? (16:1-4a)

Questions for Discussion & Application

- 1. What was surprising, confusing, or helpful from this passage?
- 2. What does it mean for Jesus' disciples to not be of the world? What does this look like in your own life?
- 3. How have you seen or experienced the hatred of the world in your own experiences?
- 4. Why is it helpful to be expecting rejection, opposition, and hatred from the world?
- 5. How should we respond to the rejection and hostility of the world? (see Matthew 5:43-45 & Romans 12:14-21)
