Looking at Life Correctly – Isaiah 2:6-22

- 1. The false hopes of Judah were expressions of human pride (2:6-9).
 - false spirituality
 - false strength
 - false gods
- 2. God will <u>humble</u> all expressions of human pride and He alone will be exalted (2:10-21).

3. We must trust in God and stop trusting in human strength (2:22).
