Assyria, the Lord's Tool – Isaiah 10:5-19

1. Assyria was merely a <u>tool</u> in the Lord's hand (10:5-6).
2. Assyria saw herself, not as a tool, but as being greater than the Lord (10:7-14).
3. Assyria was <u>humbled</u> by the Lord (10:15-19).
Questions for Discussion & Application
1. What was confusing, convicting, or encouraging from this study of scripture?
2. Is there ever a time when God is not in control? Even when His enemies seem to be strong?
3. How have you seen God work through persons who are rebellious against Him?
4. What successes do you need to give credit to God for?
5. How will God ultimately humble His enemies? (See Revelation 20:11-15.)
6. How does it encourage you to see the bigger picture of what God is doing and how things will ultimately end?
