4. Parent's Goal: Bring them up
A. Exegesis
Active voice indicates continual action -     on-going activity! You bring them up.
a. Not passive: "be brought up"
b. Not middle: "bring yourselves up"
Consistent with Rom 5:12; Prov 22:6,15
2. Present tense: continuing action
3. Imperative mode: a <u>command</u>
4 Goal: active, not passive @kevincarson

Proverbs 22;6 does not mean that if you punch the right buttons you will automatically have the right product.
