- 3. Why does it take such disciplined mental effort to keep our hope fully fixed on what God has promised us? What helps you to do this?
- 4. As those who have been saved by God's grace, we are called to be holy. Why does God want His people to be holy?
- 5. Being holy means, in part, that we are no longer conformed to the passions of our former ignorance. What former passions must you continue to turn away from?
- 6. Is it surprising to you that our passage instructs us to live in fear? What is meant by this fear? How has such a healthy fear been a part of your walk with Christ?
