

The Fruit of being begotten through the Word – I Peter 1:22-2:3

1. You are begotten through the Word to love one another deeply (I Peter 1:22-2:1).

2. You are begotten through the Word to crave the pure spiritual milk that helps you to grow (I Peter 2:2-3).

Questions for Discussion & Application

1. What was confusing, convicting, or encouraging from this study of scripture?
2. How does this passage challenge you personally? How will you respond in obedience to what you have heard?
3. The instruction to love one another earnestly from a pure heart is grounded in the reality that we have been born again through the Word of God. How have you experienced an earnest and pure love from other believers?
4. In 2:1 we are instructed to lay aside the attitudes and actions that will quench love in our community. Which of these do you feel the need to put away in your own life?
5. In 2:2-3 we are instructed to long for the “pure spiritual milk” of God’s Word. What is the good result of this longing? How is God increasing your thirst for His Word?
