Submission to Authority – I Peter 2:18-25

It is a gracious thing when we are able to submit to an unjust authority because of an awareness of God. (vss. 18-20)
Christ has set us an example of submitting to unjust authority out of an awareness of God, and we are called to follow in His steps. (vss. 21-23)
Through the unjust suffering of Jesus, God has brought us spiritual healing. (vss. 24-25)
