

God's Mercy in Moses' Calling – Exodus 3-4

God chooses to accomplish His mission through Moses, a weak and doubting vessel.

Before God calls Moses to his difficult mission, God mercifully reveals Himself to Moses and assures Moses that He will be with him.

God mercifully encourages the weak faith of Moses and makes concessions to help him embrace his mission.
