You should run from sexual sin because your body matter as the <u>resurrection</u> of the bod teaches us.
You should run from sexual sin because your body is a <u>temple</u> in which God's Spirit dwells.
You should run from sexual sin because your body is not your <u>own</u> for you were bought with the blood of Jesus.
