Liberty should be <u>limited</u> by our love for others (10:23-30).
Living for the glory of God is always <u>linked</u> together with living for the good of others (10:31-33).
We must choose to <u>imitate</u> the right role models (11:1).
Application & Discussion Questions

- 2. What should you consider to be more important; your rights and freedoms or what will profit and build others up? (See I Corinthians 13:5, Romans 15:2, and Philippians 2:4.)
- 3. Where do you need to consider what is best for others instead of simply considering what you have the right or freedom to do?
- 4. What questions could you ask yourself if you are not sure if you should do something or
- 5. Why is living for the glory of God necessarily linked together with living for the good of others? (See Matthew 22:36-40.)
- 6. Paul encourages the Corinthians believers to imitate him as he imitates Christ. This teaches us the importance of Christian role models. Do you have a Christian role model? If yes, who? Are you a Christian role model for anyone else?
- 7. How does this passage challenge you personally?
