

The Necessity of Beautiful Feet - Romans 10:14-21

No one can be saved apart from hearing and believing the message of Christ.

The necessity that the lost hear the gospel in order to believe it, means that we who know and believe this good news must proclaim it to the lost.

Not everyone who hears the word of Christ will believe this good news. In fact, most among Israel in Paul's day who heard the message of Christ did not believe.

Israel's unbelief was not because they did not hear the message nor because they did not understand it but because they were disobedient and contrary.

2. How are you challenged to action by the knowledge that people cannot be saved apart from hearing the Gospel?
3. How did you first hear the Gospel message?
4. Why are the feet of those who proclaim the Gospel said to be beautiful?
5. Whose feet were beautiful in bringing the message of salvation to you?
6. Do you know any lost persons who have not heard the Gospel message clearly proclaimed? If so, how can you seek to share the Gospel with them?
7. Why does hearing the Gospel message sometimes not result in saving faith?
8. How can we see again both God's sovereignty and man's responsibility in today's passage?
