## The Necessity of Beautiful Feet - Romans 10:14-21

No one can be saved apart from hearing and believing the message of Christ.

The necessity that the lost <u>hear</u> the gospel in order to believe it, means that we who know and believe this good news must proclaim it to the lost.

Not everyone who <u>hears</u> the word of Christ will believe this good news. In fact, most among Israel in Paul's day who <u>heard</u> the message of Christ did not believe.

Israel's unbelief was not because they did not <u>hear</u> the message nor because they did not understand it but because they were disobedient and contrary.

- 7. Why does hearing the Gospel message sometimes not result in saving faith?
- 8. How can we see again both God's sovereignty and man's responsibility in today's passage?
