Both the weak and the strong Christian should <u>accept</u> one another without quarreling or judgement.

Both the weak and the strong Christian should <u>do</u> all things with thanksgiving to God and to honor the Lord.

Both the weak and the strong Christian should <u>remember</u> that they will stand before the Lord and give an account to God for their own lives.
