## **Questions for Discussion & Application**

- 5. Before Israel could experience the miracle of crossing the Jordan on dry land, first the feet of the priests bearing the ark of the Lord had to step into the water. What did this make very clear to Israel? Why is this so important?
- 6. How does this passage encourage and challenge you personally?
