Joshua challenged Israel's self-trusting commitment to the LORD.

Questions for Discussion & Application

1. What questions do you have about today's passage and message?
2. Take a moment to recount the history of God's incredible grace to you. What sins and temptations which could have destroyed you, has God forgiven and rescued you from?
3. Why does God's incredible grace demand a total commitment to the LORD? In Romans 12:1 we see a description of this response to God's grace. In what way can your life become more and more of a living sacrifice to the Lord in response to His incredible grace?
4. Why do you think Joshua told Israel in verse 19 that they were NOT able to serve the LORD? Does this shock you?
5. What is necessary for sinners like us to be able to faithfully serve the LORD? (See Ezekiel 36:27, Acts 2:14-21, and Galatian 5:16.)
