

The Divine Son Stooped Beneath Angels – Hebrews 2:5-9

God created humanity in His image to rule over all creation, but this rule was interrupted by sin and death.

Jesus, as the perfect man, has defeated death and reigns over all creation, even though we do not yet see everything subject to Him.

Questions for Discussion & Application

1. What questions do you have about today's passage and message?
2. Who did God originally subject the world to? (See Genesis 1:28.)
3. What interrupted our ability to rule the world? (See Genesis 3.)
4. What is the "world to come" spoken of in verse 5? (See Hebrews 11:16, 12:22, & 13:14.)
5. Why did the Divine Son become a little lower than the angels? (See verse 9.)
6. How does it encourage you to know that Jesus is the resurrected King who is "crowned with glory and honor" and that everything will be made subject to Him?
7. How do we participate in all things becoming subject to King Jesus?
