Questions for Discussion & Application

1. What questions do you have about today's passage and message?
2. How do you "consider Jesus" in a world that wants you to consider and focus on everything else?
3. In what ways does our passage teach us that Jesus is superior to Moses? Why would this have been an important point to the original recipients of Hebrews?
4. What will protect our hearts from becoming hardened by the deceitfulness of sin?
5. How are you practicing the command to "exhort one another every day"? How can you grow in obeying this command?
6. Why was the vast majority of the generation that God took out of Egypt unable to enter the rest of the promised land (3:19)?
7. How does the fact that so many in Israel were participants in the externals of true religion and yet had unbelieving hearts, serve as a caution to Christians today?
